PRIMARY DAY UNIFORM

Primary Day Uniform is worn four days each week:

- Purple polo
- Boys: Navy school shorts
- Girls: Navy skirt
- Black leather school shoes
- Navy MCC school socks



SECONDARY FORMAL UNIFORM

Secondary formal uniform is worn each day:

- **Boys:** Button-up shirt, navy school shorts and belt, tie for assembly and formal occasions.
- **Girls:** Button-up blouse, tie, navy skirt or tailored shorts.
- Black leather lace up school shoes.
- Navy MCC school socks.



SECONDARY PE UNIFORM

Secondary PE uniform is worn during PE lessons. After the lesson, students must change back into their formal uniform:

- Purple polo
- Navy sports pants
- Navy MCC school socks
- Lace-up joggers



HOUSE UNIFORM

Primary students:

- House shirts are worn one day each week when students have PE lessons

Secondary students:

- House shirts are worn for inter-house events such as athletics or swimming carnivals. Students may also use their house shirts for PE lessons
- Coloured polo
- Sports shorts
- Navy MCC school socks & joggers



ASSOCIATED ITEMS

Hats



Primary hat and Secondary sport hat – must be worn for PE lessons and whenever students are playing outdoors.



Secondary formal hats must be worn to and from school and any time students are in the sun.

Every student must have a MacKillop Catholic College backpack.

Students may choose from the range of options for MacKillop jackets and cardigans.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

Other requirements applicable to ALL College students

Grooming:

- Hair is to be of suitable style that befits the school uniform.
- Hair must be kept off the face, and long hair must be tied back and kept up off the collar.
- No extremes in hairstyles, including, but not limited to fades, tracks, extreme fringes, cornrows, mullets, mohawks and ratstails, as determined by the College.
- Hair should be kept clean, neat and tidy.
- Hair should not be dyed in colours that bring attention to the student (no bright colours and no dreadlocks) as determined by the College.
- Hair accessories (ties, scrunchies, ribbons and clips) should be minimal and in keeping with the College colours (navy, purple and/or white). Oversized and ostentatious hair pieces such as 'Jo Jo bows' are not acceptable.
- Boys should be clean shaven.
- Hairstyles, including undercuts, may employ nothing less than a number 2 comb.
- Aerosol deodorant and body spray cans are not permitted – roll on deodorant only.

Jewellery:

- One white/brown/black or silver/gold plain wristwatch.
- No smart watches are permitted.
- No anklets, plastic wristbands.
- One pair of small sleepers/studs plain gold or silver only, worn in lower ear lobe (no coloured earrings). Earrings are not to have any dangling attachments.
- Clear earrings are acceptable for additional piercings.
- One small signet style ring permissible.
- If students choose to wear devotional jewellery, it is not to be visible.
- No other jewellery is permitted.
- No visible facial piercing.

Cosmetics:

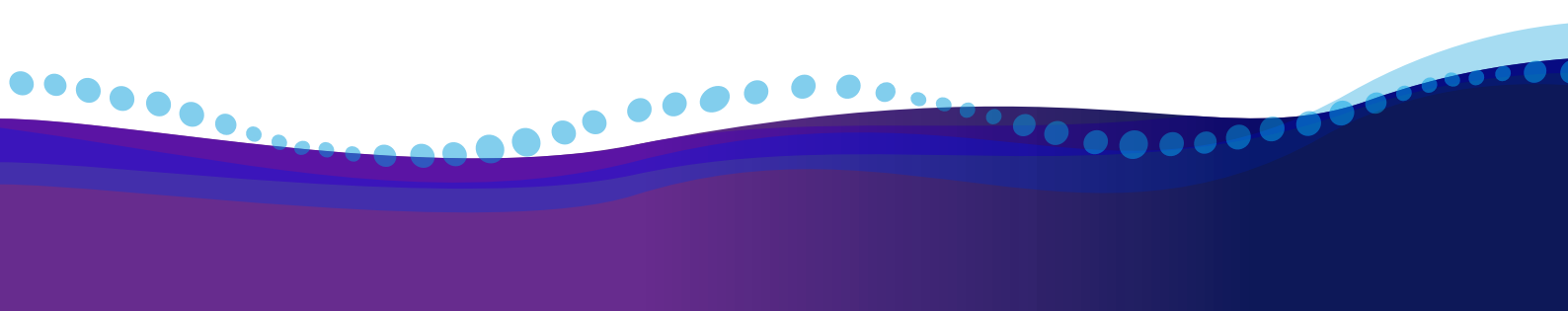
- No makeup is to be worn to school.
- No coloured nail polish is to be worn (clear or French polish only).
- Fake tans, acrylic nails, and false eyelashes are not permitted.
- Body art is not to be visible.

Headwear:

- In respect to those of other faiths, a navy head covering may be worn

Hosiery:

- In respect to those of other faiths, opaque navy or black tights may be worn.
