Dear Parent, Carer and Applicant,

MacKillop Catholic College is offering a number of scholarships to students entering Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 in 2023. The aim of the scholarships is to value effort, success, and excellence in the Academic, Music and Sport domains.

Each scholarship covers up to 100% of the tuition component of the MacKillop Catholic College fees. Scholarship applications are available from Student Reception, the College website, and the Parent Portal.

Students are invited to apply for the following scholarships.

## St Ignatius Scholarship for Academic Excellence

The St Ignatius Scholarship is available to students in Years 7 - 10 in 2023 and is tenured for the duration of the 2023 Academic Year. The scholarship covers up to 100% of the tuition component of the MacKillop Catholic College fees. The scholarship is awarded on the following criteria:

- Completion of the ACER Placement Test. Level 1 for Years 7 and 8 and Level 2 for Years 9 and 10. (Please note the costs involved in sitting the ACER Academic Assessment Exam will be borne by the applicant and is payable on registration with ACER). Please register here: <u>ACER Scholarships</u>
- 2. Evidence of demonstrated academic achievement and application to study from current school
- 3. Evidence of extra-curricular and community leadership and service
- 4. Evidence of exemplary behaviour and presentation
- 5. A demonstrated sense of community and leadership
- 6. Exhibit qualities compatible with the ethos and values of MacKillop Catholic College
- 7. Interview with the College Principal and Deputy Principal Secondary, demonstrating commitment to upholding the values of the College

# **Music Scholarship**

The MacKillop Catholic College Music Scholarship is offered to music students who currently play a music ensemble instrument. It is awarded based on the following criteria:

Inspiring Hearts, Minds and Spirits

Evidence of demonstrated engagement and success in Music

- An audition
- A commitment to representing the College in Music
- Evidence of extra-curricular and community leadership and service
- Maintenance of a C Grade or higher in all subjects
- Evidence of exemplary behaviour and presentation
- A demonstrated sense of community and leadership
- Exhibit qualities compatible with the ethos and values of MacKillop Catholic College
- An interview with the College Principal, Deputy Principal Secondary and Head of Performance

The Music Scholarship covers up to 100% of tuition and music fees for 2023 Academic Year. It is conditional on participation and success in music ensembles, as well as continued enrolment in Music as an academic subject.

# Sporting Scholarship

The MacKillop Catholic College Sporting Scholarship is offered to students who currently compete in sport at a representative level. It is awarded based on the following criteria:

- Evidence of Regional, State or National representation in a chosen sport,
- A commitment to representing the College in sport
- Evidence of extra-curricular and community leadership and service •
- Maintenance of a C Grade or higher in all subjects
- Evidence of exemplary behaviour and presentation
- a demonstrated sense of community and leadership
- exhibit qualities compatible with the ethos and values of MacKillop Catholic • College
- An interview with the College Principal, Deputy Principal Secondary, and Head of Sport.

The Sporting Excellence Scholarship covers 100% of tuition fees for the 2023 Academic Year. It is conditional on their continued participation and success in their chosen sport.

## **Application Process**

Parents/guardians of applicants are required to complete an Application for Scholarship. Each application needs to be accompanied by:

- Applicant's Academic Reports for the previous two years.
- Two references in support of the application. This may include the school principal or a teacher, community leader, parish priest or minister, employer, sporting coach or club leader. Names and addresses of referees should be provided to validate the references.

Inspiring Hearts, Minds and Spirits

- A personal handwritten statement of 400-500 words (*to be completed by the student*) outlining their strengths, achievements and how they live the values of faith, hope, love and respect in their daily lives and schooling.
- Registration with and attendance at the placement test/audition.

Please observe the following timeline for the awarding of the 2023 Scholarships:

- Application packs available from Student Reception, the College Website and Parent Portal on **Wednesday 26 October 2022**.
- Academic Scholarship applicants must register and pay online for the ACER test by Wednesday 9 November 2022.
- Scholarship Applications close on Friday 11 November 2022.
- Academic ACER Test at the College on Thursday 24 November at 4pm in the Theatre.
- Interview for Scholarship applicants will occur on Monday 28 November to Wednesday 30 November 2022.
