UNIFORM GUIDELINES

PRIMARY UNIFORM

Primary Uniform is worn four days each week:

- College polo shirt.
- Navy shorts or skirt.
- Black leather school shoes.
- Navy MCC school socks.



SECONDARY FORMAL UNIFORM



Junior formal uniform is worn each day:

- **Option 1:** Junior purple blouse (worn tucked in), navy skirt, culottes or shorts, junior girls cross-over tie, black leather lace-up school shoes, navy MCC school socks.
- **Option 2:** Junior purple shirt (worn tucked in), navy formal shorts worn with a belt, junior boys long tie, black leather lace-up school shoes, navy MCC school socks.

Note: Options 1 or 2 to be worn in their entirety.

Senior formal uniform is worn each day:

- **Option 1:** Senior purple blouse with tartan trim, senior tartan skirt or navy tailored shorts, senior girls tartan tie, black leather lace-up school shoes, navy MCC school socks.
- **Option 2:** Senior purple shirt with tartan trim (worn tucked in), navy tailored shorts worn with a belt, senior boys tartan tie, black leather lace-up school shoes, navy MCC school socks.

Note: Options 1 or 2 to be worn in their entirety.



SECONDARY PE UNIFORM

Secondary PE uniform is worn during PE lessons. After the lesson, students must change back into their formal uniform:

- College sports polo.
- Navy sports shorts.
- Lace-up joggers in primarily white, black or navy (no skate shoes, Vans etc).
- Navy MCC school socks.



HOUSE UNIFORM

Primary students:

- House shirts are worn one day each week when students have PE lessons.

Secondary students:

- House shirts are worn for inter-house events such as athletics or swimming carnivals. Students may also use their house shirts for PE lessons.
- Coloured polo.
- Lace-up joggers.
- Navy MCC school socks.



ASSOCIATED ITEMS

Hats



Primary hat and Secondary sport hat – must be worn for PE lessons and whenever students are playing outdoors.



Secondary formal hats must be worn to and from school and any time students are in the sun.

Winter Jackets

Students may choose from the range of options for MacKillop jackets and cardigans.

Backpacks



Every student must have a MacKillop Catholic College backpack. The backpack has a lifetime guarantee from Primary to Secondary.



OTHER REQUIREMENTS

Other requirements applicable to ALL College students

Grooming:

- Hair is to be of suitable style that befits the school uniform.
- Hair must be kept off the face, and long hair must be tied back and kept up off the collar.
- No extremes in hairstyles, including, but not limited to fades, tracks, extreme fringes, cornrows, mullets, mohawks and ratstails, as determined by the College.
- Hair should be kept clean, neat and tidy.
- Hair should not be dyed in colours that bring attention to the student (no bright colours and no dreadlocks) as determined by the College.
- Hair accessories (ties, scrunchies, ribbons and clips) should be minimal and in keeping with the College colours (navy, purple and/or white). Oversized and ostentatious hair pieces such as 'Jo Jo bows' are not acceptable.
- Boys should be clean shaven.
- Hairstyles, including undercuts, may employ nothing less than a number 2 comb.
- Aerosol deodorant and body spray cans are not permitted – roll on deodorant only.

Jewellery:

- One white/brown/black or silver/gold plain wristwatch.
- No smart watches are permitted.
- No anklets, plastic wristbands.
- One pair of small sleepers/studs plain gold or silver only, worn in lower ear lobe (no coloured earrings). Earrings are not to have any dangling attachments.
- Clear earrings are acceptable for additional piercings.
- If students choose to wear devotional jewellery, it is not to be visible.
- No other jewellery is permitted.
- No visible facial piercing.

Cosmetics:

- No makeup is to be worn to school.
- No coloured nail polish is to be worn (clear or French polish only).
- Fake tans, acrylic nails, and false eyelashes are not permitted.
- Body art is not to be visible.

Headwear:

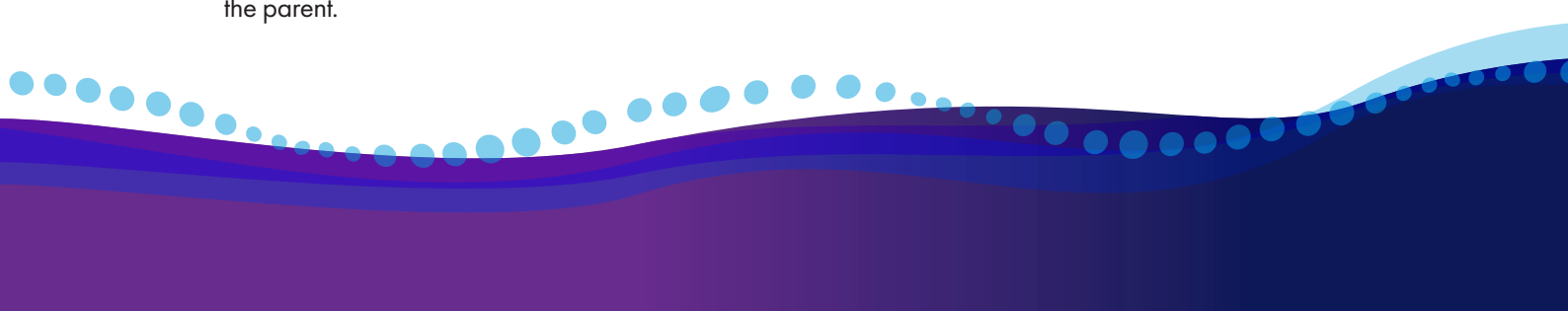
- In respect to those of other faiths, a navy head covering may be worn.

- In respect to those of other faiths, opaque navy or black tights may be worn.

- Any special orders for sun protection or cultural requirements can be assisted by the College at full cost to the parent.
